The crime of endangerment is considered one of the most common crimes today, and this crime is reflected in Article 117 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan. This crime is qualified by adding it together with other articles in the investigation and judicial practice. The crime of endangerment is mainly used in conjunction with the following articles of the Criminal Code, which are:

- Article 104 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- Article 105 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- Article 116 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- Articles 266 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

What is endangerment? Endangerment means that as a result of the act of the guilty person, the victim is deprived of the opportunity to defend himself and does not provide any help to the victim, the guilty person puts the victim in a dangerous situation, and this situation leads to moderate or severe bodily harm. Several investigative actions are carried out in connection with crimes related to endangerment, and these investigative actions are carefully carried out by the investigative authorities. Examples of investigative actions are:

- Inspection is the act of investigation;
- Investigative action of expert examination;
- Investigative action of taking samples for examination;
- Interrogation is an investigative act;
- Facilitation investigative action;
- Investigative action to show for recognition;
- Investigation of evidence at the scene of the incident;
- Experimental investigations can be conducted.

The investigative movement is an investigative movement that is carried out in order to find traces of a crime, material evidence that is important for the case, to determine the situation where the incident occurred and other circumstances.

Inspection There are seven types of investigative actions, including 1) inspection of the scene, 2) inspection of the corpse, 3) inspection of animals, 4) inspection of the surrounding area, 5) inspection of buildings, 6) inspection of objects, 7) there are types of document review. Inspection investigative action consists of three stages, the first stage is the preparation stage, in this stage, before starting the investigative action, the things used by the investigator should be prepared according to the committed crime. The second stage is the stage of conducting an investigative action, and at this stage we can mention the actions carried out by the members of the Investigative Task Force. The investigation operative group consists of an investigator, an operative representative, an expert, a preventive inspector, and canine experts. In this group, actions are carried out based on the tasks given by the investigator, and the inspection process is videotaped with the participation of at least two impartial people. When inspecting the scene of the accident, the expert criminalist first enters the scene of the incident and takes photos and videos of the scene, as well as the things and items related to the work taken from the scene of the incident are taken in the prescribed manner, and all the small details found at the scene of the incident and obtained by the expert are grounds for initiating a criminal case. can be During the investigation, the investigator is required to be thorough and send the items important for the case to be examined in procedural order. The entire process of conducting the review investigation will be videotaped and will require the participation of impartial, expert and expert witnesses. On the basis of crime traces or other information obtained during the inspection, it is determined that no crime occurred. After the review investigation has been conducted, the results must be formalized on the basis of a report, and this is considered the third step. The following should be reflected in the report: the name of the report, the time and place of the report, the conditions of the report, the persons involved in the report, the names of the technical means used, and how and in which order the documents and items were sealed. Inspection and investigation actions are reflected in articles 135-141 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

In the course of the investigation of the crime of endangerment, the investigative actions carried out by the investigators today have not been formed in a certain sequence, as well as the fact that no manual has been developed about the steps to be taken during the investigative actions, and there are some things that need to be paid attention to during the investigation for various reasons. we can witness that it is going. For example, according to Article 266 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in order to clarify whether

the actions of the person who committed the crime have the symptoms of Article 117 of the Criminal Code, it is necessary to pay attention to the investigation of the place where the incident happened, interrogation and experiment.

In the event of such situations, the traces left by car tires, where the point of collision is, where the injured person went and landed, if the oil belonging to the vehicle belonging to the vehicle was spilled at the place of the road traffic accident, blood stains on the head of the injured person, belonging to the car if there are traces of paint, it is advisable to take samples for examination of blood stains and paint on the head of the victim. The fact that this investigative activity was carried out based on the established requirements may be a solution to the problems in the implementation of future investigative activities.

Article 266 and Article 117 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan are qualified together, and in the course of investigative actions, interrogation, examination of evidence at the scene of the accident, it is necessary to pay special attention to the experimental investigative actions, because when inspecting the place of the incident with the instructions received during the interrogation the data obtained may be proportional to each other. Therefore, it is necessary for the investigator to thoroughly prepare for the investigation, prepare a list of questions to be asked in the interrogation process, clarify his personal information, and it is appropriate to ask the following questions to the accused: how fast was the car moving in km/h? 2) Tell me, have you seen a pedestrian walking on the side of the road when you were driving on the road where the traffic accident occurred? 3) Tell me, have you tried to stop the vehicle when you saw a pedestrian moving from the road while you were driving? 4) Tell me, if you saw a pedestrian moving from the road while you were driving, how much distance did you try to stop the vehicle? 5) Tell me, have you ever seen a person walking on foot fall down or bleeding somewhere as a result of a road traffic accident that hit a pedestrian? 6) Tell me, have you rendered first aid to a pedestrian as a result of a road traffic accident? 7) Tell me, who was the first person you told about your accident when you hit a pedestrian? 8) Tell us, can you show us the place where the traffic accident happened? 9) Tell me, who else was in the vehicle at the time of the road traffic accident?

Expertise, this investigative action is considered an investigative action that cannot be delayed, and this investigative action is conducted before the initiation of a criminal case. The expert's opinion is considered important for the criminal case, but does not have legal force. The expert's conclusion also depends on the validity and level of the questions asked by the investigator, and the expert provides answers only to the questions reflected in the decision. Expert opinion is considered important in criminal cases related to Article 266 of the Criminal Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
